Team

Each doubles team will consist of one CERTIFIED Junior and one CERTIFIED Adult Bowler. Bowlers may participate as often as they wish but only once with each partner. Tournament open to any person with membership in GPUSBC. Local Dues may be purchased on site at a cost of \$2.00.

Lane Assignments

The tournament director assigns Lanes, if you wish to bowl with friends and/or relatives on the same pair of lanes send entries together with an attached note indicating which entries wish to bowl together.

Youth awards will be given on the ratio of 1 award for every 6 entries or major fraction thereof in each division. Medals and scholarship dollars for first place. All others placing in standings will be awarded scholarship dollars.

Handicap Handicap will be 100% of 220 on an individual basis.

Averages

1. Use highest year book average from the 2008-2009 year book, minimum of 21 games. Rule 319a-2 does not apply. Rule 319d does not apply
2. If no book average, use current high average of 6 games or more as of January 1, 2010. **Current Standing Sheet required.**
3. If rule 1 or 2 does not apply and the participant bowled in a 2009 certified Summer League with 9 games or more the Summer League Average will be used provided there is verification of the average.
4. If rules 1, 2, or 3 do not apply then one of the following applies:
 - a. The participant is a member of a bowling organization identified as 'Professional'; the participant will use 220 regardless of book average.
 - b. The participant does not have a current average with six games as of January 1, 2010; the participant will use 165 for a woman or 170 for a man or 120 for a youth. USBC Rule 319e will not apply.
5. Reporting incorrect averages. Rule 319a-3 applies.

Dress code: No hats will be worn by any participant. No clothing with questionable words or graphics will be worn by any participant. No undergarments will be visible. The Tournament Director will have the final authority to define the appropriateness of clothing worn by any participant.

Confirmation: No confirmation will be sent unless you do not receive your first choice.

Electronics: No use of any personal electronic device will be allowed during tournament play.
