FORMAT: Each event will consist of three (3) games bowled on one pair of lanes.

CLASSIFICATION & HANDICAP: Each entry will be classified based on average in accordance with the tables below. There will also be a scratch division available for any bowler, for all of the events.

Division Breakdown: Team Average: Division 1: 561 & Over – Handicap: 100% of 880 Division 2: 560 & Under – Handicap: 100% of 880 Doubles Average: Division 1: 281 & Over – Handicap: 100% of 440 Division 2: 280 & Under – Handicap: 100% of 440 Singles Average: Division 1: 141 & Over – Handicap: 100% of 220 Division 2: 140 & Under – Handicap: 100% of 220

SIDE POTS: Scratch side pots will be run. Entry is optional, and the cost is \$5 per bowler. Winnings will be paid out in SMART Scholarships.

AWARDS: A ratio of 1 out of 5 entries or greater per division will determine payouts.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: Bowlers may enter as many times as they wish in Team, Doubles, and Singles. However, bowlers can only cash once in each event. ALL EVENTS will consist of the first (1st) scores bowled in the Team, Doubles, and Singles events.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions are allowed in Team or Doubles entries provided at least one-half of the original entry bowls. Substitutions are not permitted in Singles. Tournament Office must be notified at check-in prior to the squad time.

ELIGIBILITY: All entrants must be current USBC Youth Members. Bowlers will use their highest USBC certified average for the 2023-2024 Fall or Summer season (minimum of 21 games). If no such average is available, the highest certified league average for 60 games or more at the time of the first tournament participation will be used. If none of the above applies, an average of 200 will be used.

TOURNAMENT ATTIRE: NO HATS. Shirts must have sleeves. All clothing must be presentable. The Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify any participant based on inappropriate attire. No undergarments will be visible at any time. No electronic devices, headphones or earbuds.

PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITY: Participants are responsible for reading and adhering to all tournament rules. Failure to read or follow rules will not be considered a valid excuse for disqualification.

USBC RULES: USBC rules apply to all situations not covered above. Electronics are not permitted during tournament play. Protests and appeals must be submitted in writing and will follow USBC Rule 329.
