TOURNAMENT RULES

The Women's Championship will be held at **Rainbow Lanes**. **DATES:** June 6-7th, 13-14th 2026

ENTRIES ARE OPEN to current members of the GPUSBC

1. AVERAGES: It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average regardless of who originally submitted by the bowler, their average. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections prior to, or at the time of bowling will disqualify the scores if the submitted average is lower than the actual average.

(a) Bowlers will use their 2024-2025 **USBC Standard Composite Average**

(b) If a bowler does not qualify under (a) above, they will use their highest current average in a certified league of 21 games or more at the time of their first tournament participation. **Verification of average (printed standing sheet) to be used must be submitted at time of their first tournament participation or you will be entered at the 220 average.**

(c) If none of the above applies an average of 220 will be used.

(d) **Reclassification:** USBC Average adjustment Rule 319C will apply.

2. Multiple Participation: Multiple participation is permitted. No more than two bowlers may be the same on multiple teams. Must change partners for multiple participation in doubles. Cash only once in singles. All Events may only be entered once.

3. Entries: Entries will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Every effort will be made to accommodate your first choice of dates and squad times.

4. Refunds: Refunds will not be issued after the entry has been processed unless a calculation error has been made. Refunds based on bowler substitutions or changes will not be honored. NOTE: Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or from fires, strikes, lockouts, or labor difficulties shall cause the posted prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination.

5. Prize Fund: Payouts for each event will be based on the following ratios of payouts to number of entries: Team- 1 in 5; Doubles- 1 in 6; Singles- 1 in 8; All-Events- 1 in 10.

6. All Events: To be eligible for the separate All Events prize fund, bowlers must be entered in team, doubles, and singles events and pay the optional \$10 All-Events entry fee prior to bowling their first event. In the case of multiple participation, the first team, doubles and singles events bowled will be used in calculating the bowler's All Events total score. The bowler's All Events division will be based on their division in the singles event.

7. BOWLERS MUST CHECK IN 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO BOWLING. Team captains will only receive notification if there is a conflict with the chosen squads. It will be the team captain's responsibility to notify their teammates of the scheduled times.

PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITY: It is the responsibility of all participants in this tournament to read and be aware of all the rules. Failure to have read the rules will not be considered a valid excuse if a disqualification is necessary.

8. THIS TOURNAMENT WILL OFFER THREE DIVISIONS AS FOLLOWS:

9. Singles and Doubles will be bowled as a 6-game set, starting at 2:00 PM each day.

10. Handicap will be based off 90% of 220

11. Substitutes: Team Captains must furnish and file the name, membership number, and average of any substitute prior to the scheduled start time. No changes will be made to the order of bowlers in the Team Event or Doubles Event after the original entry has been accepted by the Tournament Director. Substitutes shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant for the entry fee that was paid or be expected to give the original entrant any prize money and/or awards the substitute may receive unless they so desire.

12. Captain's Responsibilities: Check in your team at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled start time. Be prepared to show proof of current GPUSBC membership for all members of your team, which may be required. Present any substitutions to the Tournament Director as soon as they are available, verify all bowlers' averages prior to check-in, make sure all team members are in proper attire before your squad begins, and disburse all prize checks to those members of your team that cash within 30 days of the end of the tournament. All prize checks will be sent to the team captain for disbursement.

13. Dress Code: Participants must wear a shirt and slacks, casual slacks, jeans, or skorts. Traditional collared shirts and mock collared shirts and Tee shirts (no obscene pictures or words) are acceptable attire. During participation in any event, bare midriffs, halter tops or short shorts are not permitted. Tournament Management reserves the right to determine appropriate dress.

14. All USBC Rules and Guidelines will be followed.
